This letter provides notification of a personnel change at Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC). Prior to the end of 1993, the Superintendent - Quality Assurance and the Superintendent - Plant Quality Programs, will exchange responsibilities and titles. Following is a description of both positions.

Superintendent - Quality Assurance

The Superintendent - Plant Quality Programs will assume the position of Superintendent - Quality Assurance. The Superintendent - Quality Assurance is responsible to the Senior Vice President - Nuclear Power for ensuring that an Operational Quality Assurance Program is developed, implemented, and maintained to meet the licensing requirements and management objectives. He is responsible for final review of changes to the OQAP and for final approval of changes to the Quality Assurance Directives. He is responsible for review of directives which control activities affecting quality. He is independent of cost and scheduling considerations and has the authority and organizational freedom to identify quality problems, stop work on non-conforming activities associated with plant operations until deficiencies have been corrected; initiate, recommend or provide solutions, and verify implementation of corrective actions. The Superintendent - Quality Assurance maintains stop work authority for nonconforming activities associated with plant operations by reporting them to the Senior Vice President - Nuclear Power.

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He has responsibility for ensuring that functions and activities of the Quality Assurance Staff are controlled and performed in accordance with approved directives which implement the requirements of the OQAP.

The Superintendent - Quality Assurance shall, as a minimum, meet the requirements of ANSI N18.1-1971 and should have a minimum of a B.S. degree in Science or Engineering from an accredited college or university, a minimum of five years experience in power plant construction, engineering and/or plant operation, and a familiarity with codes and regulations.

Superintendent - Plant Quality Programs

The Superintendent - Quality Assurance will assume the position of Superintendent - Plant Quality Programs. This position is responsible to the Manager - Nuclear Plant Support Services and has been delegated the responsibility for verifying the effectiveness of plant quality activities and has the onsite Quality Control Group reporting to him. He is responsible for review of nuclear administrative directives for consistency with the OQAP. He has the authority and organizational freedom to identify quality problems, initiate, recommend or provide solutions, and verify implementation of corrective actions. He is responsible for the administration and implementation of Inservice Inspection, steam generator inspection services, and Quality Engineering activities. He has a direct communications link to the corporate QA staff in matters affecting quality.

No additional organizational changes are anticipated in conjunction with these changes. WPSC has concluded that this change strengthens the WPSC organization, is administrative in nature, and does not involve a safety concern. This change does not affect the Operational Quality Assurance Program Description or the KNPP Technical Specifications.
