MANAGEMENT ACTIONS TAKEN

1. A QA audit was completed on the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant Fitness for Duty Program which resulted in no significant findings.
2. An audit of MetPath Inc. was conducted on May 17-19, 1994 by Wisconsin Electric Power Company to provide documented evidence that MetPath was performing analysis of specimens in accordance with 10 CFR 26. MetPath is the primary Fitness-For Duty testing laboratory for Wisconsin Public Service and Wisconsin Electric Power Company.
3. The computerized random selection program was modified to reduce the selection rate to 50%.

DATA ANALYSIS RESULTS/PROGRAM CHANGES IMPLEMENTED

Switched to MetPath laboratory on 1-31-94. Submitted a total of 50% blind performance test specimens for 90 day period.

EVENTS REPORTED UNDER 10 CFR 26.73

A written report was submitted on May 19, 1994 noting the findings of our investigation of several anomalous blind performance test specimens.
