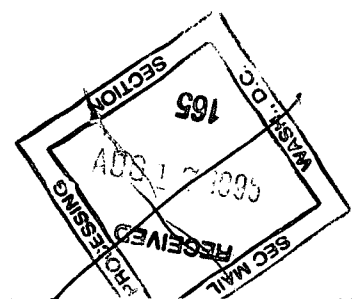
1. A QA Audit was completed of the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant Fitness For Duty Program which resulted in no significant findings.
