Supplemental Response to Generic Letter 95-07 - Clarification

 - 4) Letter from C. R. Steinhardt (WPSC) to Document Control Desk (NRC) dated November 15, 1995.

Subsequent to the transmittal of Reference 4, the NRC requested clarification on the implementation of actions in response to Generic Letter 95-07. A revised response is provided below and supersedes the response provided in Reference 4.

Reference 1 requested certain actions from licensees on a 90-day and 180-day schedule and a response within 60 days indicating the licensee's intended actions. Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC) submitted its 60-day response to GL 95-07 for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant in Reference 2. In our response, we discussed the industry effort in developing screening criteria, requested the 90-day actions of GL 95-07 be waived, and stated that WPSC would comply with all actions and responses specified in the 180-day response.

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Reference 3 provided the NRC's review of WPSC's 60-day response and stated that the NRC does not find WPSC's submittal to be fully responsive. The NRC requested WPSC to commit to the 90-day requested actions of GL 95-07 or provide the safety basis for determining the acceptability of the planned alternative course of action by November 15, 1995.

This letter provides WPSC's commitment to the 90-day requested actions of GL 95-07 which are to 1) perform a screening evaluation to provide confidence that no short-term safety concerns exist regarding particular valves as a result of pressure locking and thermal binding and 2) document the basis for operability of these valves, or if operability cannot be supported, take appropriate action in accordance with the Kewaunee Technical Specifications. WPSC also reaffirms our commitment to all actions and responses specified in the 180-day response.
