The licensee's renewal application did not include the number of gauges of each model. I called the licensee to request the number of gauges that they needed. The RSO stated that currently they possess 15 Troxler portable gauges as follows: 4640-B (7), 4640 (3), 3440-A (3) 3411-B (2). I discussed with him their two licenses (01 and 02 (PA)) for the gauges and asked if he expects that all of these gauges will be in use in NRC jurisdiction at any one time. He stated that he did not expect more than two gauges in NRC jurisdiction at any one time and stated that currently there are only two gauges in use in NRC jurisdiction.

I suggested to him that it was unnecessary to put all 15 gauges on NRC license. He agreed that authorization for 4 gauges (2 3400 series or 3411, and 2 4640) will be sufficient on the license.
