Enclosed is a copy of the Final Report for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant Exercise conducted September 23, 1997. Participants included the State of Wisconsin, Kewaunee County, Manitowoc County, and the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant.

No Deficiencies were identified for the State or Counties.

Two new ARCAs were identified during the exercise for the State of Wisconsin. Two ARCAs were identified for Manitowoc County. No ARCAs were identified for Kewaunee County. However, one planning issue was identified.

Based on the results of the September 23, 1997 exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Wisconsin, Kewaunee and Manitowoc Counties site specific to the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant can be implemented. These plans are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site.

Therefore, the Title 44 CFR, Part 350, approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Wisconsin site specific to the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant, granted on June 14, 1985, will remain in effect. The State of Wisconsin, Kewaunee County, Manitowoc County, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Division of Reactor Program Management, the Regional Assistance Committee (RAC) and the FEMA National Office were provided copies of the report.
