Mr. McCabe stated that the company had only one job in West Virginia and that was many years ago. He confirmed that it was greater than 5 years ago. The job involved a lead abatement training assignment at West Virginia University – Morgantown (WVU). The device used was an RMD Corporation XRF unit which contained a Cobalt-57 source. WVU set up the training session and obtained all necessary approvals. Inspector's note: At the time of the training, the use of Cobalt-57 was regulated by the State of West Virginia.
