10:45 Mr. Jacobs returned my call. I explained to Mr. Jacobs that as part of the NARM Reconciliation Team my responsibility was to identify and determine the cause of differences between the Connecticut list of registrants and the NRC lists of licensees. I informed Mr. Jacobs that the list included an address not found on the NRC license, i.e., 808 Washington Avenue, New Haven CT. Mr. Jacobs stated that, about a year ago, one of the two XRF units kept in North Haven, CT was transferred to the New Haven facility. The State of Connecticut DEP was informed of the transfer but, due to an oversight, the NRC license was not amended. Mr. Jacobs stated that he would see to it that an amendment request is immediately sent in to the NRC RI office requesting the change. The licensee does not possess any devices containing NARM.
