Dear Mr. Dietrich:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether there was deliberate forgery on quality assurance documents to reflect that quality assurance verification checks had been performed on electrical cords at the Southern California Edison Company's San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, San Clemente, California.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not determined to be willful. The NRC plans no further action related to the willful aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
