MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Request for Additional Views Regarding Site Visit Request)

In a July 6, 2011 memorandum and order, the Licensing Board asked for the views of applicant AREVA Enrichment Services, LLC, (AES) and the NRC staff regarding a July 5, 2011 request by the Snake River Alliance (SRA) to attend a planned July 11, 2011 visit by the Board and AES and the staff, as the parties to this mandatory hearing, to the site of the proposed Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility and its environs. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Schedule for Comments on Request to Attend Site Visit) (July 6, 2011). In its July 6 response, the NRC staff indicated it had no objection to the SRA request. See NRC Staff Response to Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Memorandum and Order Dated July 6, 2011 (July 6, 2011) at 1 (unpublished). AES, on the other hand, asserted that Commission precedent, specifically language in the Commission's decision in Exelon Generation Co., LLC (Early Site Permit for

Clinton ESP Site), CLI-05-17, 62 NRC 5, 49-50 (2005), essentially bars the Board from granting

the SRA request to attend the site visit. See Comments on Request to Attend Site Visit (July 6,

In light of the AES and staff responses, the Board requests that on or before 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time on Friday, July 8, 2011, the staff and SRA provide the Board with their views regarding whether the Commission's Clinton ESP decision cited by AES bars the Board from granting the SRA request.

In addition to service of this issuance via the agency's E-Filing system, the Board requests that the Office of the Secretary e-mail a copy of this issuance to SRA at the addresses provided in SRA's July 5, 2011 e-mail. Also, the Board requests that (1) the staff, in addition to submitting its response to the July 6 AES comments via the E-Filing system, e-mail its response to SRA at the same addresses; and (2) SRA e-mail any response to hearingdocket@nrc.gov, as well as the e-mail addresses for the Board, AES, and the staff that are set forth in the certificate of service that accompanies this issuance.
