Enclosed is Amendment No. 17 to your NRC Material License No. 21-32035-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the major changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

We noted that your letter dated March 28, 2011, requested that Drs. Abhinav Raina and Gregor McKendrick become Authorized Users for "10CFR 35.100 limited to Cardiovascular clinical procedures."

The referenced license, Amendment No.09 to 21-26635-01, supported Drs. Raina and McKenrick's authorization for the use of materials in 10 CFR 35.200. Therefore I assumed that the typos in your request were an oversight and I amended the license as it appeared you intended, although it was not stated as such in your letter.

In addition, NRC no longer lists Authorized Users for the use of materials in 10 CFR 35.200 with any type of restrictions on the NRC Form 374 license document itself. The restrictions for Drs. Raina and McKendrick is expressed on your license by the inclusion of your March 28, 2011, letter in the last condition of your license, also called the "tie-down" condition.
