Dear Sir or Madam:

This is an administrative appeal of the NRC's flawed "no records" response. I appeal on the grounds that the search was insufficient and that the 'no records' finding constituted a constructive denial of records without cause.

The NRC has received a number of requests from various requesters for records concerning sightings of unidentified flying objects near nuclear generating plants.

The NRC has reportedly responded to each and every one with the same answer: no records. However, news reports and anecdotal evidence, as well as common sense, indicates that there are such reports and sightings of unknown origin.

The consistent "no records" response in the face of there being reports and records suggests that the Commission maintains a formal or informal policy in responding to such requests. I myself requested a copy of this policy or guidance in the subject request but was informed that there is no such policy, something that presses the boundaries of credulity.

For the reasons described above, I believe that the NRC initial response was flawed and should be reversed.
