On April 11-16, 2005, Commissioner Merrifield led a delegation from the United States, including staff from the NRC and the Department of State, to participate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> National Report Review Meeting of the Convention on Nuclear Safety (CNS), in Vienna, Austria. The CNS is a treaty ratified by 56 countries (Contracting Parties) to ensure the safe use of nuclear energy around the world. Each country is required to submit a report for peer review by the other Contracting Parties every three years to demonstrate that it complies with the Articles of the Convention. Then, each country is required to provide a presentation of its report during the National Report review meeting and answer any questions that the other Contracting Parties may have, after hearing the presentation.

The two-hour presentation of the U.S. report was presented by Commissioner Merrifield and Luis Reyes, the Executive Director for Operations. At the conclusion of the presentation, the two presenters answered questions for an additional two hours. The session concluded with the drafting of the report on the U.S. presentation by the group secretary (called the Rapporteur) to highlight good practices, challenges, and measures to improve safety, which is later read to the entire collection of Contracting Parties and approved at a plenary session during the second week of the review meeting.
