

DOMINION NUCLEAR CONNECTICUT, INC. (DNC) MILLSTONE POWER STATION UNITS 2 AND 3 NRC BULLETIN 2011-01 MITIGATING STRATEGIES SIXTY-DAY RESPONSE

On May 11, 2011, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Bulletin 2011-01, "Mitigating Strategies." The NRC issued this Bulletin to achieve the following objectives:

- 1. To require that addressees provide a comprehensive verification of their compliance with the regulatory requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 50.54(hh)(2),
- 2. To notify addressees about the NRC staff's need for information associated with licensee mitigating strategies under 10 CFR 50.54(hh)(2) in light of the recent events at Japan's Fukushima-Daiichi facility in order to determine if 1) additional assessment of program implementation is needed, 2) the current inspection program should be enhanced, or 3) further regulatory action is warranted, and
- 3. To require that addressees provide a written response to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(f).

The NRC requested two separate licensee submittals in response to the Bulletin as follows: 1) within 30-days from the date of the Bulletin confirm continued compliance with 10 CFR 50.54(hh)(2), and 2) within 60-days from the date of the Bulletin provide requested information associated with their mitigation strategies programs for 10 CFR 50.54(hh)(2). The DNC 30-day response for Millstone Power Station (MPS) Units 2 and 3 was submitted to the NRC on June 9, 2011 (Serial No. 11-290B). Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(f), the 60-day response to provide information regarding MPS Units 2 and 3 mitigating strategies under 10 CFR 50.54(hh)(2) is provided in the attachment to this letter. The attachment contains Security-Related information that should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390.

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The 60-day response includes information that addresses measures that are currently in place, as well as additional planned actions with expected completion dates. The additional planned actions are considered voluntary enhancements.
