Dear Mr. Wiza:

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license. As we discussed with Donald Jordan, the Assistant Radiation Safety Officer by telephone on May 17, 2011:

- In Item 8.B. we have listed the total possession limit for leak test samples not to exceed 10 millicuries per leak test sample and 100 millicuries total except as specified in license condition 14.
- In Item 8.C. we have listed three single sources not to exceed 30 millicuries per device and a total possession limit not to exceed 300 millicuries.
- In Item 8.D. we have listed two 12.5 millicurie sources not to exceed 25 millicuries per device and a total possession limit not to exceed 250 millicuries.
- In Item 9.A. we have listed **only use** incident to the installation, relocation, removal, servicing and packaging of fixed and portable gauging devices at customers' facilities.
- And finally, License condition 10.B. specifies that you **do not take possession** of the radioactive material(s) and /or source(s) in Item 6.A. while at the client's facility.
