This letter is in response to your June 21, 2011, letter requesting additional information concerning an application for amendment to license number 45-25330-01. For convenience, the responses below are keyed to the items in your letter.

1. Dr. Rechner received a total of 16 hours of didactic training in the 6 areas on her Statement of Training and Experience, P. 2. She received an additional 32 hours of supervised clinical training specific to Radiocat's operations.

2.a. These courses were taken to fulfill the requirements for a clinical residency in radiation oncology and academic credit was not recorded in credit hours.

b. The Patients referred to were animals.

c. Training at NC State and UNC in Rules and regulations governing the uses of sources of radiation, principals of radiation safety, Radiation and radioactivity measurements, instruments and techniques, Mathematics basic to the use or measurement of radiation or radioactivity, and Biological effects of radiation is sufficiently general to apply to Radiocat's

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program. Training in safe handling and use of I-131 in unsealed form has been provided by Radiocat.
