I spoke with Mr. Cislak about the project. He indicated that the company had a specific license with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for thin lift asphalt work. Wilfred Clough would be the person to speak with about the work performed and that he was located at 901 River Road, East Deerfield, MA as stated in the CT Registrant's list. I left a message on Mr. Clough's voice mail for him to get back in touch with me. 11:15 Mr. Clough returned my call. It was determined that the company has a specific license (MA 48-0380) that authorizes a Troxler Model 4640 gauge containing cesium-137 and americium-241 sealed sources at temporary jobsites. Mr. Clough reviewed his records and determined that the licensee performed work in CT on two occasions: 12/6/06 Route 171 in Union, CT and 7/7/08 Rt. 190 in Stafford, CT. Mr. Clough also indicated that the company has an asphalt plant in CT which might require future visits. Also, Mr. Clough stated that all of the measurement work in the past few years has been farmed out to another company since they are short-handed. I explained the reciprocity process to Mr. Clough and how getting a permit from CT, though required by CT, was not enough to perform the work conducted in 2006 and 2008. I gave him contact information should the company decide to perform work in CT. Mr. Clough stated that he would probably cancel his permit with CT and farm out any future work to another engineering firm. I told Mr. Clough that I would need to brief management on my findings and the NRC would get back in touch with the licensee concerning what action the NRC would take.
