Enclosed is Amendment No. 17 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-13687-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

**Please note that we updated the activity values listed in Item Nos. 8. A and 8. B for sources used in the Troxler Electronic Laboratories Model Nos. 3400 Series. These values reflect the more conservative values based upon the error values allowed in the Sealed Source Device Registry. These changes should not have any impact on your Radiation Safety Program.**

**We also removed Condition No. 11. B as it appeared on Amendment No. 16. Due to an NRC policy change, you will not be able to change and name your Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and Alternate Radiation Safety Officer (ARSO) internally as Condition No. 11. B previously allowed. NRC must do that for you via the amendment process.**

**For future RSO/ARSO changes please submit the name of the proposed RSO/ARSO; his/her training and experience qualifications; a statement signed and dated by the proposed RSO/ARSO that s/he accepts the position as RSO and that s/he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with the RSO position.**

**Lastly updated License Condition Nos. 13. D, 15, 16, and added 13. F. These changes should enhance your awareness of the radiation safety program elements in your license and our regulatory requirements.**

In accordance with 10 Code of Federal Regulations 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
