Dear Secretary Vietti-Cook,

In the wake of the crisis at Fukushima, it has become clear that we cannot afford to take any risks when building nuclear reactors. Because a disaster can occur at any nuclear reactor, the NRC needs to immediately suspend the building of any new Westinghouse AP1000 reactors, several of which are currently being considered for construction in Georgia, South Carolina and other states.

Westinghouse has not satisfactorily proved that the thin steel containment shell over the reactor would be effective during severe accidents or that the reactor could be properly cooled in conditions similar to those at Fukushima.

Considering the ongoing crisis in Japan, THERE REALLY IS NO SUCH THING AS 'SAFE' NUCLEAR ENERGY!!

Also, please accept the petition filed by the 12 environmental organizations of the AP1000 Oversight Group and to ensure transparency, please include this comment and all others in the formal review proceedings and post them in the NRC's online library so the public can see any expressed concerns.
