Re: Transfer of Control for license No. 21-26764-01, Grand River Cardiology, PLC

Our facility, currently known as Grand River Cardiology, PLC, License No. 21-26764-01, will become part of Saint Mary's Health System. This transfer of ownership will take place on August 1, 2011.

- Grand River Cardiology will become a subsidiary of Saint Mary's Health Care through the sale of assets, and will no longer be a private corporation. The name will be Grand River Cardiology. The PLC will be dropped from our name.
- There will be no changes in personnel or duties related to licensed activities at Grand River Cardiology. Any new personnel will be required to complete the same training as now required. Grand River Cardiology will be managed separately from other departments in the Saint Mary's Health Care as a separate department as a member of care.
- There will be no changes in the organization, location, facilities, equipment or procedures that relate to the licensed program.
- Grand River Cardiology maintains a compliant surveillance program and is audited quarterly by a medical physicist to insure they remain compliant with the current radiation protection program and all NRC regulations. Grand River Cardiology will continue to maintain a compliant surveillance program during and after the transfer of ownership. There are no open inspection items related to materials license number 21-26764-01.
- Grand River Cardiology maintains a compliant surveillance program and is audited quarterly by a medical physicist to insure we remain compliant with the current radiation protection program and all NRC regulations. Grand River Cardiology will continue to maintain a compliant surveillance program during and after the transfer of ownership. There are no open inspection items related to materials license number 21-26764-01. Documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods of sensitivity will be transferred to Saint Mary's Health Care.

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
