Dear Ms. Norman:

I am writing to you regarding the Shallow Land Disposal Area (SLDA) Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) site in Parks Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania. The SLDA facility is currently owned and operated by Babcock & Wilcox Technical Services Group (BWXT) of Lynchburg, Virginia and regulated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) under NRC License Number SNM-2001. As you know, the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is scheduled to begin a cleanup of radioactive waste at that site, consistent with the 2001 Memorandum of Understanding between the NRC and USACE.

During the course of USACE's remediation, Cabrera Services will also be on site on behalf of BWXT, under NRC License Number 06-30556-01. Cabrera Services' work on behalf of BWXT will not impact USACE's commitment to maintaining health, safety, and security within site boundaries, which is the continuing and sole responsibility of USACE while the NRC License is suspended for USACE remediation activities.
