We have received a request from Exelon for a 401 certification of the Exelon Victoria County Station Site. In order to complete our 401 certification process I need some additional information.

We understand that authorization for any discharge of dredged or fill material will be handled under a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Section 404 permit and that any requirements for a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit under Section 402 will be processed under the existing permitting processes and authorities. The purpose of this email is to confirm that no other discharges to waters of the U.S. will be authorized by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) besides the two listed above.

If there are any other discharges to waters of the U.S. being contemplated in association with this NRC license I would greatly appreciate your assistance in identifying those. Please give me a call if you wish to discuss.
