Called Mr. Volz to ask if the transfer of a GL Device (APD-2000, serial #754) to Scientific and Environmental Consulting, Inc. (SECI) on Nov. 19, 2010, was included their Quarterly report to FSME/GLTS. Mr. Volz was informed that a review of NRC records did not identify a record of the transfer.

Mr. Volz stated that he had identified an error in their report for the fourth quarter of 2010, the quarter when the device was transferred from Smiths Detection to SECI. He further stated that the error was due to an oversight and the reason for the error involved a computer application error. Mr. Volz said he would fax a letter to RI regarding the details of the error, including an updated report for the fourth quarter of 2010.

Mr. Volz also reiterated that Smiths Detection will only ship GL devices to the end user and that they include all transfers in their quarterly reports to NRC.

RI received the letter and report from Mr. Volz via facsimile on July 28, 2011.
