

**PROGRAM SCOPE**

The licensee had performed in-vitro laboratory experiments. The licensee had stopped using radioactive material and has decommissioned its site. The last waste shipment was February 15, 2011. The licensee believes that they may wish to use byproduct materials in the future. The licensee agreed to request for a stand by license. The Radiation Safety Officer on the license is a consultant. Note to the next inspector, the Radiation Safety Office is located in Building L, Section L-6.

**Performance Observations**

The inspector took measurements in the last laboratory decommissioned and inside the waste storage room. Records of the surveys for decommissioning of two labs were reviewed. The last financial audit and the last few years of dosimetry records were reviewed.
