NRC STAFF UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD

In its June 2, 2011 Memorandum and Order (Providing Presentation Topics, Additional Questions, and Administrative Directives Associated with Mandatory Hearing on Environmental Matters) ("Order"), the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Licensing Board") specified topics for evidentiary presentations to be presented by the NRC staff and AREVA Enrichment Services, LLC ("AES") at a mandatory hearing on environmental matters concerning AES's 10 C.F.R. Part 70 application for authority to construct and operate the proposed Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility ("EREF") in Bonneville County, Idaho. Pursuant to that Order, the staff presented exhibit NRC000190, NRC Staff Presentation Topic 3, Greenhouse Gas Impacts of Facility's Production Power Consumption, on July 12, 2011, at the mandatory hearing on environmental matters.

During the presentation, the Licensing Board asked a specific question regarding the greenhouse gas ("GHG") emissions that would be produced if electricity used by the EREF were provided by electrical generators in the Northwest Power Pool ("NWPP"). See Transcript at 497-505. In seeking to provide a more complete response to the Licensing Board's question than the staff was able to provide at the oral hearing, the staff discovered an error in its presentation with regard to the EREF GHG footprint if all electrical power for the facility were provided by coal-fired plants.

The staff seeks to correct the error regarding the GHG footprint from coal-fired plants

and supplement the information provided to the Licensing Board regarding the NWPP.¹ To that end, the staff submits the "Affidavit of Bruce M. Biwer Concerning the NRC Staff Unopposed Motion to Amend and Supplement the Record" (NRC000216) and an additional supporting reference (NRC000217) and respectfully requests that these documents be admitted as staff exhibits in this proceeding.
