Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license. As indicated in a telephone conversation between Leonard Sueper of your staff and myself on July 19, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit (200 millicuries) for licensed materials listed in Subitem 8.B. These changes were made in a corrected copy to Amendment No. 09 to your NRC Material License No. 22-08799-09.
