On July 28, 2012 I spoke to B. Kodery about his amendment request to add a rubidium-82 generator (CardioGen-82). According to an FDA correspondence dated 7/26/11, the CardioGen-82 generator is being voluntarily recalled by the manufacturer, Bracco. At that time B. Kodery stated that he would like to withdraw his amendment request. After further discussions with RI staff, it was determined that an amendment was not necessary because Rb-82 falls under 35.200 for imaging and localization. On 8.1.11 informed B. Kodery that an amendment was not necessary because their license currently authorizes 35.200 use at the PET facility at 148 East Avenue, Norwalk, CT.
