<u>ORDER</u>

(Scheduling Initial Scheduling Conference)

In accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.332, the Board will conduct an initial scheduling conference by telephone on Thursday, August 11, 2011 at 2:00 PM EDT for the purpose of developing a scheduling order to govern this proceeding. Prior to the conference call, the parties should familiarize themselves with the relevant procedural rules of 10 C.F.R. Part 2.

Among other matters, the parties should be prepared to address the following subjects during the conference call:

- Whether the Board's consideration of summary disposition motions would expedite the proceeding.
- 2. Selection of the appropriate type of hearing.
- 3. Discovery issues.
- Deadlines for the parties' respective initial statements of position and written testimony.
- 5. Hearing date and location.
- 6. Legal issues, including but not limited to:

a. Does the Board review Honeywell's exemption request "ab initio," as asserted

in its request for a hearing?¹

b. Burden of proof.

c. Is satisfaction of the specified criteria in 10 C.F.R. § 40.14 a necessary but

not necessarily sufficient condition for granting an exemption from the

requirements of the regulations? If not necessarily sufficient, what other

criteria must or should the NRC consider in determining whether to grant an

exemption?

Before the conference call, the parties shall confer in good faith for the purpose of

reaching agreement on the foregoing issues, insofar as practicable. If the parties are unable to

reach agreement on legal issues, the Board will permit subsequent briefing.

Additionally, the Board expects to ask questions concerning the licensee's ownership

structure and any joint venture participation, and their impact on decommissioning funding

obligations. The Board may also pose written questions on these and other subjects in the

scheduling order.

On or before Tuesday, August 9, 2011, representatives of each of the parties should

the conference call. Members of the public or media who wish to listen to his conference call
