The following information is supplied as requested in your letter of October 12, 1978 (copy attached).

The specific location at which the byproduct material is used is Tuckerton Road, Muhlenberg Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania.

Relative to Item 14, the leaks tests are performed by Boulder Scientific at their facility. We return the portion of the Model 200 device containing the sealed source to Boulder Scientific for source exchanges. Since for analytical purpose, we only use a source for three months, we return the device prior to the six month swipe test interval requirement and thus Boulder Scientific takes responsibility of performing the required test.

In regard to source exchanges, we are not performing this activity. As mentioned above, we return the portion of the Model 200 device containing the sealed source to Boulder Scientific for the source exchanges. The word shield as used in Items El5, El6, El8 and El9 of our instructions for using the Model 200 analyzer actually means that portion of the instrument that contains the sealed source.

I hope that the above information is sufficient to support our renewal application.
