SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE JULY 28, 2011, NUCLEAR REGULATORY
COMMISSION CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION PROGRAM
CATEGORY 3 PUBLIC MEETING.

On July 28, 2011, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of New Reactors (NRO), held a public meeting to discuss and solicit feedback from industry and members of the public on the proposed expansion of the ITAAC closure notification examples, staff comments on five additional inspection, test, analysis, and acceptance criteria (ITAAC) closure notification examples, and the applicability of ITAAC maintenance to piping design acceptance criteria (DAC). Brief updates were also provided on the Commission paper for enforcement discretion during construction and Interim Staff Guide (ISG)-24 on complex ITAAC (Agencywide Documents Access and Managements System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML11194A289).

The meeting began with a brief update, presented by Earl Libby from the Division of New Reactor Licensing, on the Commission paper for enforcement discretion during construction, followed by an update from Ronaldo Jenkins, of the Division of New Reactor Engineering, on the status of ISG-24.

The Staff's comments on the five proposed ITAAC Closure Notification examples (ML112092005) were provided by Ed Kleeh from DCIP. The Staff found the level of detail in three of the five examples sufficient to support ITAAC closure verification. A good dialogue between the Staff and industry ensued for the two remaining examples which industry intends to revise and resubmit for NRC review.

A brief discussion on the applicability of ITAAC maintenance to piping DAC was held. The issue is being addressed by the DAC working group. It was agreed that this would be a topic for further discussion in future meetings.
