Enclosed is Amendment No. 13 to your NRC byproduct materials license no. 13-26510-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

**In your correspondence to us dated November 18, 2010, and March 23, 2011, you indicated that you wished to release for unrestricted use a former address of use and area of use, located at 207 Sparks Avenue, Jeffersonville, Indiana.**

**The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former address of use and area of use, located at 207 Sparks Avenue, Jeffersonville, Indiana, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.**

**Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this address of use and area of use and they are suitable for unrestricted use.**

approve the release for unrestricted use of your former location of use at NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you.

This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
