PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee was a private practice physician office and authorized to use licensed material permitted by Section 35.100 and 35.200 at the Waterford Michigan clinic location. The nuclear medicine department was staffed with two full-time technologists. The technologists performed approximately 24-32 diagnostic nuclear cardiology procedures per month. The licensee received unit doses from a licensed radiopharmacy. The clinic retained the services of a consulting physicist who audited the radiation safety program on a quarterly basis.

Performance Observations

The inspection consisted of interview with licensee personnel, a review of select records, tour of the nuclear medicine department and independent measurements. There were no scheduled patients while the inspectors were present and therefore the inspectors were unable to observe any administration.
