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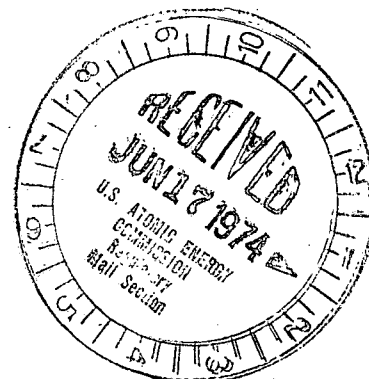
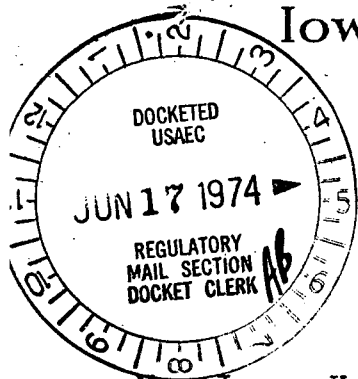

This letter is to report to you with respect to certain Technical Specification Surveillance requirements at the DAEC.

Problem

Specification 4.8.A.1.d states, "Once a month a sample of diesel fuel shall be checked for viscosity, water and sediment. The values for viscosity, water and sediment shall be within the acceptable limits specified in Table 1 of ASTM D975-68 and logged. On May 25, 1974, while reviewing the surveillance test results for April it was noted that Surveillance Test Procedure No. 48A003 covering the above noted requirement was not performed.

Investigation

The subject surveillance test prior to the month of April was performed by the Operations Group. Beginning in April the Radiation Protection Group (Chemistry) was to assume responsibility for performing the test, but due to a misunderstanding on when the transition was to take place the surveillance test was not performed.
