


In accordance with DAEC Technical Specifications, Section 6.11.2A.1, this letter is intended as notification of an abnormal occurrence at the Duane Arnold Energy Center on December 24, 1974. This letter, telecopied to your office, is intended to satisfy the requirements for notification by telegram within 24 hours of an abnormal occurrence. However, due to the Christmas holiday this letter is sent on December 26, 1974 in agreement with your Mr. Feierabend.

Identification of Occurrence

Two Suppression Chamber Water Level instruments were inoperable and reportable in accordance with Appendix A, Operating License DPR-49, Specification 1.0.4.b.

Description of Occurrence

After the performance of STP 42F006, which is the 6 month calibration frequency test for Suppression Chamber Water Level, one level recorder (LR4384c) was found inoperable and a calibration error had been introduced into level transmitter (LT4363) which controls the other recorder (LR4385B). Thus, for a very short period of time, no accurate level indication was available to the operating personnel. As this instrumentation performed no automatic functions there was no safety implications involved in the malfunctioning transmitters.



A formal written report will be submitted to the Office of Directorate of Regulatory Operations within 10 days of the subject abnormal occurrence.
