Summary of Violations

The above were violations of the most conservative limits of the June 30, 1975 Modifications of License and the proposed Technical Specification changes of July 10, 1975.

Previously Reported Violations

Prior to the license modification of December 27, 1974 MCPR violations occurring on 8/11/74 were reported in the DAEC Startup Test Results submitted December 23, 1974.

Immediate Actions

Upon discovery of all violations, action was taken immediately to return the parameters to within limits.

Corrective Actions

Due to the APLHGR Limits changing rapidly with exposure, it will be necessary to establish an administrative limit conservative with respect to the license limit. For continuity administrative limits will be established for both MCPR and MAPLHGR.
