It has come to our attention that an omission existed in Amendment No. 10 to your NRC Material License No. 13-32192-01. This omission has been corrected by the addition of a total possession limit in Item 8. A in the enclosed Corrected Copy of License Amendment No. 10.

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license. We have listed the total possession limit for iodine-131 as 5 millicuries in Items 8. C.
