This letter is intended to complete our response to Item 2 of IE Bulletin No. 79-14. The results of the analytical evaluation made concerning the nonconformances identified in our August 31, 1979 submittal confirm that there are no cases in which the stress levels exceed code allowables in either the "as-found" or the "as-modified" conditions. Therefore, the results of our analytical evaluation not only show that system operability was not jeopardized, but that the nonconformances neither existed at the time of our initial evaluation nor do they exist presently as a result of the modifications identified in our August 31 letter.
