DEFICIENCY 2

Contrary to 10CFR50, Appendix B, Section XVII and QDD 1450, Section VIII, the completion of training being given the general inspectors was not being documented in the inspector training program status log.

RESPONSE

1. Corrective action taken and the results achieved:

The training program status log has been brought up to date and all general inspector training has been entered.

2. Corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance:

The training program status log shall be maintained in an up to date status.



Dear Mr. Fiorelli:

This letter is in response to your letter of February 15, 1977 with the attached IE Inspection Report No. 050-331/77-02 concerning an inspection at the Duane Arnold Energy Center and Iowa Electric Light and Power Company Corporate Headquarters on January 17-20, 1977. The Inspection Report listed two items of noncompliance identified as Deficiencies 1 and 2 which require a written statement or explanation. This letter contains the reply to Deficiency 1, the reply to Deficiency 2 will be submitted separately.

Deficiency 1 stated:

Contrary to 10CFR50, Appendix B, Section V and QAP 1102.4, one of the Corporate QA auditors did not receive a course on codes within the required two years, nor was the training conducted within the past year documented for either auditor in accordance with the QAP procedure. (Paragraph 9.c, Report Details).

Response

1. Plans have been made to send the auditor who lacked the course on codes to an ASME Code Compliance seminar on July 25-27, 1977.

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2. The training records have now been up-dated to document the training conducted during the last year. This includes (a) instructions on the IELP QA Program to a new employee within a week of commencing employment and (b) the completion of a Lead Auditor Training Course by another auditor.
