
Dear Senator Bingaman:

Thank you for your letter dated June 6, 2011, to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Administrator Lisa P. Jackson regarding the Remedy Site Evaluation Report recommendations and the statistical sampling of background concerns for the Homestake Superfund site. Your letter was forwarded to me for reply because New Mexico is within the jurisdiction of Region 6.

On July 8, 2011, the EPA sent a letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) giving it a notification of deficiency under the Memorandum of Understanding between the EPA and the NRC Region IV. Specifically there are several instances where the NRC activities may not comply with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act. Enclosed for your information is a copy of the letter from the EPA to the NRC which specifically delineates the EPA's concerns.
