
Dear Mr. Muller:

On January 13, 1986, this office received from Iowa Electric Light & Power Company copies of its amendment (to Op License No. DPR-49) request dated January 9, 1986. The request related to deletion of sections on environmental qualifications superseded by 10 CFR 50.49, and other corrections and clarifications. The request was identified as proposed change RTS-193.

On April 7, 1986, this office received the monthly notice of amendment applications to operating licenses involving no significant hazards consideration. At 51 FR 10462 for March 26, 1986, the notice of the subject amendment request was included, and the basis of the NRC proposal for a no significant hazards consideration determination was explained.
