The Revision 5 changes are identified by vertical lines in the right margin keyed to a "5" indicating that a change occurs at those locations. Our internal evaluation, conducted in accordance with 10 CFR 50.59, is available in our Quality Assurance Department for your review.

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The quality assurance program, as revised, continues to satisfy the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix B, and the DAEC Safety Analysis Report program description commitments previously accepted by the NRC.


