
Dear Mr. Muller:

On November 20, 1986, this office received from Iowa Electric Light and Power Company copies of its amendment (to OP License No. DPR-49) request dated November 14, 1986. The request related to extension of certain surveillance test intervals by approximately 10 weeks to accommodate the longer cycle 8 run, prior to the refueling outage beginning approximately March, 1987. The request was identified as proposed change RTS-213.
