Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

This letter and attachments are in response to your letter dated July 11, 1980 concerning the interim criteria for shift staffing.

It is the intention of Iowa Electric Light and Power Company to achieve compliance by July 1, 1982 with the shift staffing interim criteria contained in your letter.

The schedule of actions for implementation of these requirements is attached. Accomplishment of these actions as scheduled is contingent upon recruitment, hiring, and training program success and the administrative processes of obtaining operator licenses. An evaluation by our staff of different methods available to comply with the interim shift manning requirement has concluded that the additional senior licensed operators should be obtained from the existing operations department staff. This decision was made in order to take advantage of the plant specific operating experience of our existing licensed operators. The attachments to this letter provide the projected schedules (Attachment 1) and supporting criteria (Attachment 2) developed by our staff to accomplish the increased shift manning by utilizing the existing operations department personnel.

We trust this letter is responsive to your interim criteria for shift staffing. If additional clarification of our position is necessary, please do not hesitate to contact us.

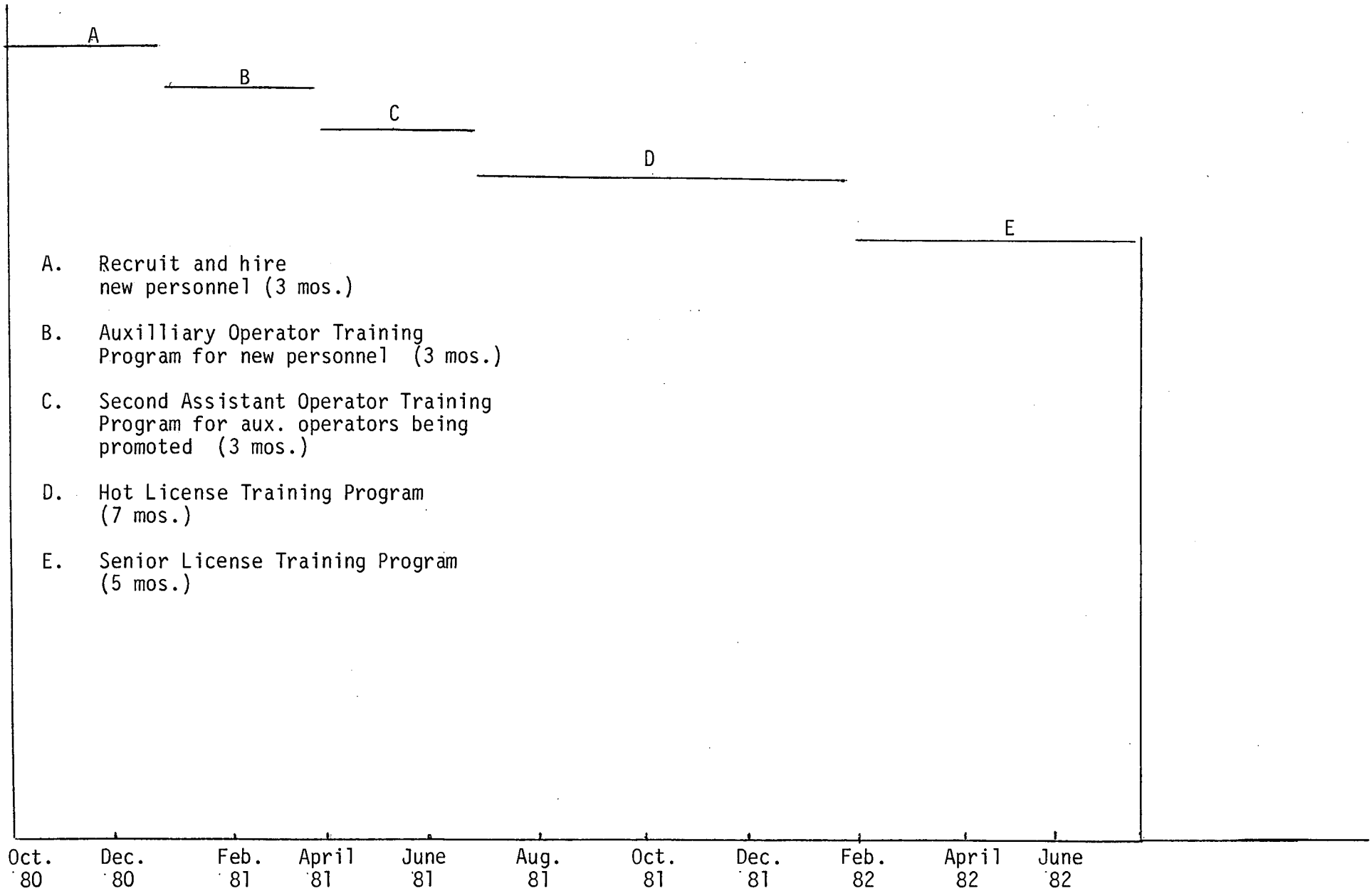
