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Attachment 2

Training Schedule Criteria

Objective: Increase shift manning to include an additional senior licensed operator for each of the six shift crews.

Restrictions and Assumptions utilized in schedule development:

1. Existing operations department staffing cannot support immediate upgrading of existing licensed operators to the senior operator level without jeopardizing our continuous licensed operator requalification program. Therefore, new personnel must be hired and trained to replace our non-licensed personnel and the existing non licensed personnel must be licensed prior to removing senior license candidates from the operating shift crews for training.
2. The process of recruiting and hiring the required number of new personnel is expected to be completed within two (2) months.
3. All training required for implementation of shift manning requirements shall comply with the Duane Arnold Energy Center Operator Training Program, Revision 4 dated August 1, 1980.
