Dear Mr. Lear:

The intent of this letter is to confirm information which was transferred in a conference telphone call between Messrs. Clark and Block of the NRC Staff and Messrs. Young, Kuehn, Hammond and Salmon of Iowa Electric on April 3, 1978. The subject of the conversation was the removal and disposal of old fuel racks and the installation of new ones at the Duane Arnold Energy Center (DAEC). These activities are required for the proposed spent fuel pool modifications at DAEC.

It is intended that divers will be used to do a minimal amount of cutting which is required for removal of the old racks. The old racks will be removed, cleaned by hydrolazing, crated and shipped intact. Installation of the new racks will be done completely without divers. The total man-dose due to occupancy for all activities related to the subject removal, disposal, and installation has been estimated not to exceed 8.5 man-rem. This compares to relative DAEC total occupancy exposure of 92.1 man-rem during 1976 and 274.8 man-rem during 1977.
