
Dear Mr. Muller:

On December 9, 1985, this office received from Iowa Electric Light & Power Company copies of its amendment (to Op License No. DPR-49) request dated December 6, 1985. The request related to addition of containment isolation valves for the loop B jet pump sample line. The request was identified as proposed change RTS-194.

On March 7, 1986, this office received the monthly notice of amendment applications to operating licenses involving no significant hazards consideration. At 51 FR 6825 for February 26, 1986, the notice of the subject amendment request was included, and the basis of the NRC proposal for a no significant hazards consideration determination was explained.

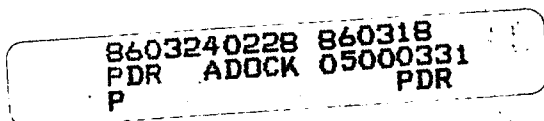
This letter is to state that as the 10 CFR 50.91(b)(3) state consultation designated contact, I have no comment.
