IOWA ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY SUBMITTAL OF INFORMATION TO BE WITHHELD FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.790 OF 10 CFR PART 2

By letter dated October 24, 1972, transmitted by Newman, Reis & Axelrad, attorneys for the Iowa Electric Light and Power Company, it was requested that the portion of Amendment No. 7 pertaining to the answer to DL question 3.13 be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Section 2.790(b) of 10 CFR Part 2. The information submitted in the answer to DL question 3.13 relates to maps of local power distribution for Beginning of Cycle and End of Cycle for the Duane Arnold Energy Center fuel design.

The information submitted in the answer to Question 3.13 is considered to be proprietary information by the General Electric Company, the designer and manufacturer of both the nuclear fuel and nuclear steam supply system. In the applicant's response to our question 3.25, we have a detailed statement of the reasons why General Electric Company believes the information is proprietary. The information supplied in answer to question 3.13 "goes beyond a detailed description of the distribution and location of U238 and U235 and Gd which must eventually be supplied by GE to the utility in order that bids for compatible reload fuel can be obtained from other vendors". Release of this information to the public would give General Electric Company's fuel design and performance data to competitors and thus handicap General Electric's competitive position in fuel technology.

In view of the foregoing, I have determined that disclosure of the information contained in the answer to DL question 3.13 is not required in the public interest nor by 10 CFR Part 9, and that it should therefore be withheld from public inspection pursuant to 2.790(b) of 10 CFR Part 2.
