Due to a change in the NRC's licensing policies, total possession limits for regulated nuclear materials need to be listed on NRC licenses. As you discussed with Frank Tran by telephone on May 6, 2011, and based on the information you provided, we have listed the total possession limit for Items 6.A and 6.B on your license.

Please note, we have updated Item D. in the leak test condition.
