This RAI addresses Structural Inspections, Tests, Analyses, and Acceptance Criteria (ITAAC), as discussed in Sections 14.3.2 of the Final Safety Analysis Report, as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3 Combined License Application, Revision 7.

The referenced letter provided a August 15, 2011 response date. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI 275, Question 14.03.02-13. The response will be provided to the NRC by September 2, 2011.
