This report is submitted in accordance with the requirements of Appendix B to Operating License DPR-49, Specifications 5.4.2.1 and 3.1.1.

#### <u>Problem</u>

In accordance with Environmental Technical Specification 3.1.1, discharge canal water temperatures are required to be logged hourly and daily by the process computer. Due to a malfunction of the process computer on May 3, 1975, discharge canal water temperatures were not recorded for the hours 1000 - 1600. Since backup temperature monitoring data provided by temperature elements in the cooling tower basin is also transmitted to the process computer, this information also was not available.

#### <u>Investigation</u>

Prior to the malfunction of the process computer, the 0900 entry in the computer balance of plant log listed the discharge canal temperature as 63.2°F. After the process computer was restored to operation, the 1700 entry in the balance of plant log listed the discharge canal temperature as 66.2°F. Since there also were no significant changes in plant load during the period the computer was inoperative, the change in discharge canal water temperature was relatively small.

## Corrective Action

A design review of discharge canal temperature monitoring techniques has been initiated. Pending completion of the review, Operating Personnel have been directed to initiate manual methods for monitoring discharge canal water temperatures during periods when the process computer is non-operative.

### Conclusion

The DAEC Operations Committee and Safety Committee reviewed and approved this report on May 13, 1975.
